

MEMBER OF GAISF

WFDF has become a member of GAISF (General Assembly of International Sports Federations). The decision was taken at the GAISF General Assembly in Colorado. In the minutes from the meeting GAISF says that we fulfill all formal admission conditions but that we are a new and to them unknown sport. Therefore we are granted provisional membership status for a year. Under that year one of the members of the GAISF council will get to know frisbee, WFDF, our statutes, rules and competitions better. At the same time it was decided that this would be the general procedure for all new sports seeking membership in GAISF. Also see separate letter from GAISF.

EBU SATELLITE CHANNEL

EBU set up a satellite sports channel in 1988 under the name Eurosports. They have sent a telex to GAISF telling this and seeking cooperation from the GAISF members. Apparently they have a need for a lot of sportsevents to broadcast in this satellite channel. It is a new possibility for the associations organising mayor tournaments the coming years.

NEXT CONGRESS

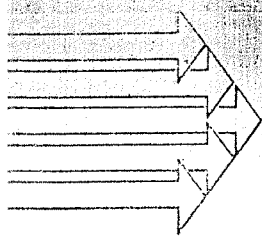

MINUTES FROM WFDF BOARD MEETING 8-9/12 1987 VIA GROUP PHONECALL

1) The meeting was declared opened when contact had been made with Johan Lindgren, Dan Roddick, Jacques Doetsch, Shinshiro Ebashi and Danny McInnis. Eric Wooten could not participate.

2) The minutes from the Congress did not acquire any comments.

3) Dan Roddick said that a full report on the GAISF meeting was on the way from Bill Wright. Dan had got a letter from GAISF stating that we had become provisional members. The letter was going to be distributed to all WFDF members.

4) There was not much to add to the financial report made to Congress. Jacques said that we had (in round number) 19000 Bfr, 2500 USD, 75 pounds and 300 Skr. He had had no contact with Brendan Nolan and had recently mailed a rather hard letter. A full financial report on the World Championship in Ft Collins is on the way from Bill Wright. Dan Roddick will contact Bill on the issue of payments to WFDF.

5) The rulebook is on the way. Scott Lash has worked hard with the rules committee and the other committees. A major rewrite has been done and the final draft is being mailed to the rules committee and the board for approval. After that the rules will be typesetted by Leonard Muise who will save the current rules on computer disc for easier future changes. It was decided that all members should receive either a photocopy of the new rules or the new rulebook early 1988.

6) Belgium next year is no problem. San Fransisco has applied for world individual 1988 in a good bid. The problem is the issue of prize money. Dan Roddick will discuss the matter with Leonard Muise. The tournament in San Fransisco is organised together with Amnesty International.

The interest from Japan is not in an individual tournament but in an ultimate and guts tournament in 90,91 or 92. It was decided to ask all interested future organizers listed in the minutes from Ft Collins to present more firm bids to the Congress in 1988.

7) The golf committee is working with next years World Cup. No decisions were taken.

8) WFDF has got an invitation from Sport Aid 88 to participate in our own way in the gathering of money for the starving in Africa. The board decided to join and Johan Lindgren will make a draft to all members.

9) The issue of a standardized WFDF trophy was discussed but no decision taken. We shall seek more ideas and views until next Congress.


10) We are invited to exhibit our sport at the world games in 1989. The german association has first contact with the organizers. Johan will request more information from the germans.

11) It was decided to hold the Congress 1988 the weekend leading up to the tournament in Belgium. During the week some seminars should take place, hosted by the WFDF people not directly involved in the tournament. Johan and Jacques invites to the Congress and Johan prepares the necessary documents.

12) There was no other issues.

13) The meeting was closed after a little over an hour.

COMING SEASONS PLANNING

Primarily it concerns Germany (ultimate+Guts 89), Norway (Ultimate+Guts 90), England (Individuals 89), Seniors (Atlanta 89),(MINneapolis 90), PDGA (Yearly championships + World Cup + other big tournaments), FPA (freestyle), EFDF (European championships). If all those organisations could make rough plans for dates and places of the two coming years and send to WFDF a lot could be gained. It is for the benefit of every organiser to have co-planning. Competing for players can be of NO interest for the sport. If WFDF can fulfill this very important task national plans can more easily be made when the international tournaments are settled.
